Hello **District**,

It's **Your Name**. Although this 2020-2021 school year has come to a close, we know students still need to access the high speed internet over the summer. Your student is eligible for the national Emergency Broadband Benefit or "EBB" program. The EBB provides a temporary discount of up to \$50 per month toward broadband service for eligible households, and up to \$75 per month for eligible households located on Tribal lands. The EBB is limited to one discounted monthly service plan per household.

As part of the enrollment process, you may be required to provide documentation of your student's enrollment in the National School Lunch Program. If so, you may request documented verification of your student's enrollment in the National School Lunch Program by contacting your student's school.
